WHEREAS the Village of Angola wishes to make application for a grant towards the cost of preparation of the plans for the project set forth below: to wit the erection of a combination Village Hall, Fire Hall, Library and Municipal building at an estimated cost of \$ 75,000.00; Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Village of Angola submit this project for consideration by the State of New York Post War Public Works Planning Commission for 50 per cent of the cost of preparation of the plans of such project, and be it further,

RESOLVED, that when and if such Commission approves this project and when and if the Commission allocates one half the cost of the preparation of the plans of such approved project, the Village of Angola will make available a sum equal to that allocated by the Commission.
